A regular meeting of the Fruitland Park City Commission was held at 506 W. Beckman Street, Fruitland Park, Florida 34731 on Thursday, September 25, 2025, at 6:00 p.m.

Members Present: Mayor Chris Cheshire, Vice Mayor Patrick DeGrave, Commissioners Martina Williams, Joseph Cosenza III and Michael Raysin

1. CALL TO ORDER, INVOCATION, AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

After Mayor Cheshire called the meeting to order, followed by an Invocation given by Jeff Hessinger, Pastor at Eagles Nest Baptist Church. Interim Chief Rains then led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

2. ROLL CALL

After the Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance, Mayor Cheshire called the meeting to order and announced decorum for the meeting. He then requested that Ms. Johns call roll where a quorum was declared present.

3. CONSENT AGENDA

Mayor Cheshire called for a roll call vote on the motion and declared it carried unanimously, 5-0.

- (a) Resolution 2025-050, Request for Vacation of Dixie Blvd., Adjacent to Lots 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, Block D. Petitioner: Tim Coates.**

Ms. Geraci-Carver read Resolution 2025-050 by title only.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FRUITLAND PARK, FLORIDA, VACATING CERTAIN RIGHTS OF WAY SHOWN ON THE PLAT OF 1ST ADDITION TO DREAM LAKE SUBDIVISION AS RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 3, PAGE 13 OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF LAKE COUNTY, FLORIDA, WITHIN THE CITY OF FRUITLAND PARK; VESTING OF TITLE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS AND SCRIVENER'S ERRORS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Anita advised that this resolution reserves a 30' ingress/egress easement over the property being vacated to allow access to a parcel that the city would otherwise not have access to, if needed. Mr. Coates is willing to grant the 30-foot easement over his property between South Dixie and the parcel being vacated to further allow access. Both of those easements will automatically terminate if the parcel that is not currently being vacated is ever vacated.

Vice Mayor DeGrave asked if this would be a dedicated or recorded easement and Ms. Geraci-Carver said yes. She said there would be a termination of easement recorded in the public records to allow for the automatic termination upon vacation of the other parcel.

ACTION: A motion was made by Commissioner Cosenza and seconded by Commissioner Raysin to approve Resolution 2025-050 as presented.

There were no public comments.

Mayor Cheshire called for a roll call vote on the motion and declared it carried unanimously, 5-0.

(b) Second Public Hearing – Resolution 2025-070, Adopting the Final Millage Rate for Fiscal Year 2025-2026.

Mayor Cheshire announced that the City of Fruitland Park is prepared to set the proposed millage rate of 3.9134 which is 10.79% increase over the roll back rate of 3.5324. The millage rate of 3.9134 mills is the same rate as in the last seven years. Once the proposed rate is established, the commission cannot exceed that rate.

Ms. Geraci-Carver read Resolution 2025-070 by title only.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FRUITLAND PARK, LAKE COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A FINAL MILLAGE RATE OF 3.9134 LEVYING OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FRUITLAND PARK, FLORIDA, AMENDING DIVISION 3 IN ARTICLE V OF CHAPTER 2 OF THE CITY OF FRUITLAND PARK CODE OF ORDINANCES TO PROVIDE FOR A PLANNING AND ZONING SPECIAL MASTER TO SIT AS THE LOCAL PLANNING AGENCY, AND IN PLACE OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING BOARD; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CITY OF FRUITLAND PARK LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Vice Mayor DeGrave asked about how long it would take to get someone into place. Ms. Geraci-Carver responded that an RFQ would be prepared, and she thought it should be issued sometime during early or mid-October.

There being no one from the public who desired to speak, Mayor Cheshire closed the public hearing.

Mayor Cheshire called for a roll call vote on the motion and declared it carried unanimously.

- (g) Resolution 2025-075, Approval of a Permanent Utility, and Ingress-Egress Easement from Adventist Health System/Sunbelt, Inc.; for Property Located on County Road 466A, west of Oliver Lane.**

Ms. Geraci-Carver read Resolution 2025-075 by title only.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FRUITLAND PARK, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE PERMANENT UTILITY AND INGRESS-EGRESS EASEMENT IN FAVOR OF THE CITY OF FRUITLAND PARK, FLORIDA FROM ADVENTIST HEALTH SYSTEM/SUNBELT, INC.; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE EASEMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

ACTION: A motion was made by Commissioner Cosenza and seconded by Vice Mayor DeGrave that the City Commission adopt Resolution 2024-075 as previously cited.

There being no one from the public who desired to speak, Mayor Cheshire closed the public hearing.

Mayor Cheshire called for a roll call vote on the motion and declared it carried unanimously.

(h) Resolution 2025-076, Removal of Historic and Specimen Trees. Petitioner: Catalyst Design Group on behalf of the owner, Birch Enterprises, LLC – Urick and Wilder

Ms. Geraci-Carver read Resolution 2025-076 by title only.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FRUITLAND PARK, FLORIDA, MAKING A FINDING THAT CONSTRUCTION OF A MULTI-FAMILY APARTMENT COMPLEX WITH CLUBHOUSE, ASSOCIATED PARKING AND STORMWATER APPROVED IN RESOLUTION 2025-022 IS NOT FEASIBLE WITHOUT REMOVING THE HISTORICAL AND/OR SPECIMEN TREES PROPOSED FOR REMOVAL BY CATALYST DESIGN GROUP; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mike Rankin, Interim Community Development Director, discussed the details of Resolution 2025-076, which would authorize the removal of historic and specimen trees. He noted that the intent of the developer was to plant a nice, landscaped area and several of the trees being removed are considered scrub or trees that would have to be removed from landscaping development due to potential erosion issues.

Reed Ellis, Director of Development at Elmington Housing, stated that 132 canopy trees would be planted, and the total will be 165 replacement trees.

ACTION: A motion was made by Vice Mayor DeGrave and seconded by Commissioner Cosenza that the city commission adopt Resolution 2025-076 as previously cited.

There being no one from the public who desired to speak, Mayor Cheshire closed the public hearing.

Mayor Cheshire called for a roll call vote on the motion and declared it carried unanimously.

7. (a) City Manager

Ms. Manila stated that she would have a land purchase for water wells and a water treatment plant contract for consideration at the next City Commission meeting.

She reminded the City Commissioners to let her know their availability for scheduling a tour of the Public Safety building. She said that substantial completion for the building is scheduled for December 2, 2025.

Ms. Manila stated that the agency account for Next Door has been approved, and she has started posting information for the community.

Mr. Rankin provided an update on development activities in the City. He stated that temporary occupancy began for the Evolve Apartment project. He stated that staff is midway through one of three temporary occupancy permits that will be issued, and he discussed the progression of activity in completing that project. He noted there had been some interest in the two commercial lots along Miller Road.

Vice Mayor DeGrave asked about the deferral of Evolve impact fees and Mr. Rankin said they have already made a payment toward the impact fees and staff is managing the payments. Ms. Fielder said the first impact was \$1.2m and they are in the process of paying all of the impact fees.

Ms. Geraci-Carver stated that the statute requires a phased in approach for the imposition of increased impact fees. The statute also caps how much impact fees may be increased unless the jurisdiction can demonstrate through a study performed by the consultant that there are extenuating circumstances. When the study is done for the impact fees for water and wastewater, staff will ask the consultant will be asked to do a demonstrated needs study to demonstrate how much the impact fees should be adjusted and whether there are circumstances to necessitate the City adopting something higher. If there are circumstances that demonstrate that, the City Commission would be required to hold two public workshops where that is the only discussion item. The consultant would make a presentation, and public input would be accepted. The Commission would need a unanimous vote in order to exceed the maximum allowed by statute, and the increase would still have to be made in a two-phased approach.

Renee Colon, 909 Paso Aly, requested an extension of sidewalk in the Oak Forest Community, at the end of Paso Aly and Urick Street. She said currently there is no sidewalk on the Paso Aly side where children have to walk to get to Fruitland Park Elementary School. She noted several safety concerns and indicated that a resident at 900 Paso Aly has harassed parents and children walking to school. Ms. Colon submitted a package of photographs to City Manager Manila.

Interim Police Chief Rains indicated that the car line is being reconfigured, which should help with the problem.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FRUITLAND PARK, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF FOUR VEHICLES FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT UTILIZING BID PRICING PURSUANT TO A CONTRACT HELD BY THE FLORIDA SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION, INCLUDING THE PURCHASE OF TWO 2025 FORD POLICE INTERCEPTORS FROM BOZARD GOVERNMENT FLEET, ONE 2025 CHEVROLET TRAILBLAZER FROM CARL BLACK ORLANDO, AND ONE 2025 CHEVROLET TAHOE 4x4 FROM CARL BLACK ORLANDO; APPROVING THE FOUR VEHICLES TO BE OUTFITTED WITH DANA SAFETY POLICE PACKAGES PURSUANT TO A CONTRACT HELD BY BRADFORD COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND THE FUNDS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Fruitland Park desires to purchase four vehicles for the Police Department and budgeted funds for such purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds acquisition of four new outfitted police vehicles serves a valid public purpose and desires to authorize funds for such purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City proposes to purchase vehicles from Carl Black Orlando using the open contract FSA-HCS-AVP1.0 held by the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office through its procurement policy which remains valid through October 27, 2028; and

WHEREAS, the City proposes to purchase vehicles from Bozard Ford using the open contract FSA25-VEH33.0 held by the Florida Sheriff's Association through its procurement policy which remains valid through September 30, 2027; and

WHEREAS, the City proposes to outfit the vehicles with Dana Safety Police Packages using the open contract BCSO2019-01 held by Bradford County through its procurement policy which remains valid through July 14, 2029;

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Fruitland Park, Florida finds it is in the best interest of the City to accept the bid pricing pursuant to a contract held by the Florida Sheriff's Association for the purchase of four police vehicles and accept the bid pricing pursuant to a contract held by Bradford County for Dana Safety Police Packages, collectively in the estimated amount of \$230,795.73, but authorizing the city manager to expend up to the budgeted amount.

BRIEF NARRATIVE: Resolution 2025-078 approves a change order with Halff Associates, Inc. for additional professional services related to the wastewater master plan update.

On January 9, 2025, the City Commission approved a professional services agreement with Halff Associates, Inc. to update the Water and Wastewater System Master Plans, develop the Reclaimed Water System Master Plan, update the water system hydraulic model, update the water and wastewater system rate & impact fees, and perform a preliminary geotechnical investigation of effluent disposal areas, should the City opt to construct its own wastewater treatment plant.

On May 15, 2025, the Town of Lady Lake held a workshop to discuss partnering with the City of Fruitland Park to build a new wastewater treatment plant in which Fruitland Park would own 1/3 of the plant's capacity. Consensus of the Lady Lake Town Council at the end of the workshop was to move forward with the partnership. With this direction in mind, Halff finalized the wastewater master plan with the understanding that the Town of Lady Lake would continue to treat wastewater from the City of Fruitland Park.

On June 9, 2025, City Manager Karen Manila received formal notification from the Town Manager of Lady Lake that the Lady Lake City Commission was no longer interested in pursuing a partnership with Fruitland Park. Because of this change, Halff was asked to update the master plan to include a new wastewater treatment plant and reclaimed water system to be built, owned and operated by the City of Fruitland Park. This change in direction caused Halff to invest a significant amount of time in not only rewriting the master plan but performing detailed analysis of wastewater treatment plant options and reclaimed water system components. This additional work required more staff to provide the timely delivery of the master plan considering the urgency to construct a new plant.

The original professional services agreement was broken down into phases for a total project amount not to exceed \$161,305, with \$52,000 of that amount budgeted for the wastewater & reclaimed water system master plan phase. The requested change order is for an additional \$25,000.

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2025, City Manager Karen Manila received formal notification from the Town Manager of Lady Lake that the Lady Lake City Commission was no longer interested in pursuing a partnership with Fruitland Park; and

WHEREAS, the City directed Halff to update the master plan to include a new wastewater treatment plant and reclaimed water system to be built, owned and operated by the City of Fruitland Park; and

WHEREAS, this change in direction caused Halff to invest a significant amount of time in not only rewriting the master plan but performing detailed analysis of wastewater treatment plant options and reclaimed water system components, and this additional work required more staff to provide timely delivery of the master plan considering the urgency build a new plant; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the professional services agreement to increase the total project amount by \$25,000.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE FRUITLAND PARK, LAKE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Based upon conversations with both the City of Fruitland Park, and the Town of Lady Lake, Halff proceeded with completing the Wastewater Master Plan with the confirmation that the Town of Lady Lake would continue to serve the City of Fruitland Park. Following the joint workshop with both entities, Halff finalized the Master Plan with the understanding that the Town would continue to serve the City. Subsequent to this workshop, Halff was notified that the Town of Lady Lake had reconsidered serving the City, and Halff was asked to update the Master Plan to include a new wastewater treatment plant and reclaimed water system, to be owned and operated by the City. Halff incurred significant additional cost to re-write the Master Plan to include the City designing and constructing their own wastewater and reclaimed water facilities, including detailed analysis of two biological processes, cost estimates, reclaimed system components, etc, and fast-tracked this additional work, utilizing several staff, in order to provide a timely delivery of the Master Plan, given the urgency of the need to build a new facility. Based upon this change, which was out of our control, we are requesting a Change Order to cover additional staff expenses.
