

REMOVAL OF CITY ATTORNEY AND ANY ASSISTANT CITY ATTORNEY BY MAJORITY VOTE OF CITY COMMISSION

- Currently the city attorney is appointed for a 1 year term coinciding with the City's fiscal year and cannot be terminated during that period unless
 1. For cause
 2. Commission holds two public meetings –
 - a. First meeting - Motion and second to terminate
 - b. Second meeting - Public hearing and vote by the Commission
- Approval of the ballot measure will allow the following:
 1. Provides for the city attorney and any assistant city attorneys to serve at the pleasure of the commission
 2. Allows the Commission to remove the city attorney and any assistants:
 - a. At any time
 - b. No advance notice is required
 - c. Motion to remove and vote can occur at the same meeting
 - d. By majority vote
 - e. No entitlement to a public hearing

HIRING OF CITY TREASURER AND CITY CLERK

- Currently the charter provides for the City Commission to appoint the city treasurer and city clerk for a 1 year term coinciding with the City's fiscal year and they cannot be terminated during that period unless
 1. For cause
 2. Commission holds two public meetings –
 - a. First meeting - Motion and second to terminate
 - b. Second meeting - Public hearing and vote by the Commission
- Performance issues and disciplinary actions can only occur during a public meeting
- Commissioners are not present in order to have day to day oversight
- Approval of the ballot measure will allow the city manager to hire, fire and discipline the city treasurer and city clerk as the city manager does with all other employees of the city

- Performance issues and disciplinary action can take place outside of the public meeting

MOVE LANGUAGE ESTABLISHING THE PLANNING AND ZONING BOARD FROM THE CHARTER TO THE CITY CODE

- Currently the charter:
 1. establishes the planning and zoning board
 2. provides for qualifications
 3. sets the number of board members
 4. sets the term of each board member
 5. states the board's purpose
- Approval of the ballot measure will allow the Commission to establish the board, etc. in the City's Code which can be changed from time to time by the City Commission without requiring a referendum
- Provides flexibility in establishing qualifications, number of board members, term of appointment, etc.

ADOPTION OF STANDARD CODE OF TECHNICAL REGULATIONS BY RESOLUTION AND PROVIDING FOR INSPECTION AND COPYING

- Currently the charter requires any code of technical regulations to be adopted by an ordinance which requires two public meetings
- Examples of technical regulations include: engineering standards for construction of roads, sidewalks, and utility facilities
- Approval of the ballot measure will allow technical regulations to be adopted by resolution which only requires one public meeting
- Allows for technical regulations to be changed more quickly and therefore can be implemented sooner
