FRUITLAND PARK CITY COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES October 25, 2012

<u>MEETING STATISTICS.</u> A regular meeting of the Fruitland Park City Commission was conducted in the Commission Chambers of City Hall, 506 West Berckman Street, Fruitland Park, Florida on Thursday, October 25, 2012 beginning at 7:00 p.m.

<u>INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.</u> Chief Terry Isaacs delivered the invocation followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Commissioner Goldberg.

<u>ROLL CALL.</u> Mayor Bell asked City Clerk Diane Gibson Smith to call the roll.

01. PRESENTED LIFE SAVING AWARDS AND INTRODUCED NEW FIRE DEPARTMENT LIEUTENANTS.

Fire Chief David Borst introduced the newly selected Fire Department Lieutenants: Michael Laming, George Fernandez, Brian Turner, and Donald Gilpin.

Fire Chief David Borst also presented Life Saving Awards to Senior Police Officer George Hunnewell, Police Officer Jared Crenshaw, Fire Chief Tommy Gamble, Lieutenant Donald Gilpin, Explorer Captain Michael Howard, Firefighter/EMT Kevin Gerry, Firefighter Josh Ranize, Firefighter Devon Salisbury, Firefighter Leo Gonzales, Explorer James Dilimone III, Deputy Chief Steve Whitaker, Lake EMS Paramedic (off duty) Angela Wilson, Lieutenant George Fernandez, Senior Engineer Tim Yoder, Lieutenant/EMT Michael Laming, Firefighter Tyler Ramsey.

02. <u>APPROVED CONSENT AGENDA AS PRESENTED</u>. Mayor Bell presented the Consent Agenda for approval.

Commissioner Goldberg moved and Commissioner Kelly seconded to approve the Consent Agenda. The motion carried unanimously. Approved were the minutes of the September 27, 2012 City Commission meeting (action and summary)

03. <u>CITY ATTORNEY'S REPORT</u> - none

04. <u>CITY MANAGER'S REPORT -</u>

a. CM Bowers stated he will bring forward a 10-year work plan for water system being worked on by Sarah Whitaker and a proposal on the well site on the Logan property.

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05. PUBLIC HEARINGS

a. <u>Tabled Ordinance 2012-030 until November 8, 2012.</u> CDD Rector stated the final revision was not completed until this morning.

Commissioner Kelly moved and Commissioner Goldberg seconded to table Ordinance 2012-030 until the November 8, 2012 City Commission meeting. The motion carried with all Commissioners voting aye.

b. <u>Adopted Ordinance 2012-031 increasing the water rates by the CPI and renaming</u> <u>the reconnection fee to activation fee.</u> CA Gerken read Ordinance 2012-031, by title only, as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FRUITLAND PARK, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 50, SECTION 50.30(A), (B), (D), AND CHAPTER 99, SECTION 99.60(B) (d) and (g) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO PROVIDE FOR AN INCREASE IN WATER RATES; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

CT Michaud stated the increase is 2.9% or approximately \$0.35 to the base rate.

Mayor Bell requested comments from the public. There were none.

Commissioner Kelly moved and Commissioner Goldberg seconded to adopt Ordinance 2012-031. The roll call vote was as follows:

The motion carried with a vote of 4 ayes and 1 nay.

06. NEW BUSINESS

a. <u>Tabled Resolution 2012-041 until the January 10, 2013 City Commission meeting</u>. CDD Rector stated the LDRs stated we must have two entrances to a subdivision exceeding 25 lots. The closing of this gate, and the subsequent vacating of the roadway, would remove the second entrance to The Glen and Wingspread. This needs to be reviewed further.

Commissioner Kelly moved and Commissioner Goldberg seconded to table Resolution 2012-041 until the January 10, 2013 City Commission meeting. The motion carried with all Commissioners voting aye.
