

FRUITLAND PARK CITY COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

February 9, 2012

MEETING STATISTICS. A regular meeting of the Fruitland Park City Commission was conducted in the Commission Chambers of City Hall, 506 West Berckman Street, Fruitland Park, Florida on Thursday, February 9, 2012 beginning at 7:00 p.m.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE. Pastor Mulford of the Grace Bible Baptist Church delivered the invocation followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Commissioner Gunter.

ROLL CALL. Mayor Bell asked City Clerk Diane Gibson Smith to call the roll.

ELECTED OFFICIALS PRESENT. Commissioner John L. Gunter, Jr., Commissioner Sharon Kelly, Commissioner Albert O. Goldberg, Vice Mayor Jim Richardson, Mayor Christopher J. Bell

MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS/OTHERS PRESENT. City Manager (CM) Ralph Bowers, Police Chief (PC) Terry Isaacs, Public Works Director (PWD) John Bostic III, City Treasurer (CT) Jeannine Racine Michaud, Community Development Director (CDD) Charlie Rector, and City Clerk (CC) Diane Gibson Smith.

01. STATE OF THE CITY

Mayor Bell presented his State of the City address. He noted we had some new staff additions – Police Chief Isaacs and CT Michaud, we were able to adopt a budget with a lower ad valorem tax without reducing services, completed comprehensive master water and wastewater plans, and were awarded a \$700,000 Community Development Block Grant which included a fully funded Lift Station. In addition we were able to secure a 30-year, interest free FDOT Hardship Loan and got approval on our 10-year CUP. For 2012, we have already annexed 84 parcels into the City. We are looking for economic growth and development, advancement on CR466A widening, a park project with Lake County which will include a convention center, and we welcome Welton Caldwell as our new Lake County Commissioner. New economic development in the works include the Bouis property, Pine Ridge Dairy property, and a BBQ restaurant. We will also be looking closely at the electric system. 2012 will be year of challenges, a year of promise, and has the potential to be biggest growth year yet.

03. APPROVED THE CONSENT AGENDA AS PRESENTED.

Mayor Bell presented the consent agenda for approval.

Commissioner Kelly moved and Commissioner Goldberg seconded to approve the consent agenda as presented. The motion carried with all the Commissioners voting aye. The minutes of the January 26 2011 LPA meeting and the January 26 2011 City Commission meeting were approved.

04. HEARD CITY TREASURER REPORT FOR PERIOD ENDING DECEMBER 31 2011

CT Michaud reviewed the report for the period ending December 31 2011. She noted the good news is revenues exceed expenditures except in the Recreation Department which should even out. Fuel is a problem. The remaining overages are mainly for annual payments being paid early in the year.

05. CITY ATTORNEY'S REPORT

- a) CA Gerken stated next Tuesday the City's CUP goes to the SJRWMD Board for approval.
- b) CA Gerken stated he received an article stating the Lake County Board of County Commissioners is considering an ordinance on Local Preference which will include reciprocity – will use the same terms as other counties to bring to level playing field. Will provide a copy of the County ordinance at the next meeting.
- c) CA Gerken stated he will be bringing back a couple of clean-up ordinances for the annexations at the next meeting.

06. CITY MANAGER'S REPORT

- a) CM Bowers reported on a recent meeting with the Lake County ROW Acquisition staff. They stated they are moving ahead well. CM Bowers noted he told them he would like to see more progress on this. The Lake County staff informed us they would provide better communication with us.

CDD Rector stated CM Bowers asked how much administrative costs were coming out of the money set aside for this. They were unable to answer this question.

- b) CM Bowers stated he received a phone call from Ray Sharp, Environmental Services Director in Leesburg. He said he was approached by Pennbroke Fairways regarding a water issue. Mr. Sharp questioned if we would consider putting well #6 on their line. Pennbroke Fairways may be able to handle the sulfur as they have a heavy treatment.

After discussion of possible problems/concerns, the consensus of the Commission was to begin discussions regarding this possibility.

- c) CM Bowers gave an update on the water issue at 1006 Lake Myrtle Breeze Court. He noted the same water lines also supply the Glen and Wingspread. These customers are receiving the same water as everyone else uses. He noted what someone does to the water after it leaves our system is not our problem. Water softeners are to soften the water; some remove the chlorine. What happens to the water once it leaves the softener is not in our control. The water they are receiving meets all the appropriate standards for drinking water.
- d) Commissioner Gunter questioned where we are with the FDOT meeting with the businesses along US441. CM Bowers stated we are working on setting up the meeting.

The decision was made to invite FDOT back to the first meeting in May to give an update.

08. INTRODUCTION OF ORDINANCES

- a) Approved first reading of Ordinance 2012-018. Mayor Bell introduced Brian Gillette of Cart Works and Frank Re of Sta-Rite Carts and Accessories. Both businesses are located within the City limits of Fruitland Park.

CA Gerken read, Ordinance 2012-018, by title only, as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FRUITLAND PARK, FLORIDA, CREATING CHAPTER 73 OF THE CITY OF FRUITLAND PARK CODE OF ORDINANCES ENTITLED GOLF CARTS AND LOW SPEED VEHICLES; AUTHORIZING THE USE OF GOLF CARTS AND LOW-SPEED VEHICLES ON SPECIFIED ROADWAYS; PROVIDING DEFINITIONS; PROVIDING RESTRICTIONS; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT AND SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

CA Gerken reviewed the changes to the ordinance since the last time it was discussed. He further noted the ordinance limits the carts to streets where the posted speed is 30 mph or less. He suggested moving this to 35 mph which is allowed by Florida Statute.

After much discussion, the decision was made for the following changes:

- Decals – golf carts/low speed vehicles
- Proof of insurance
- Fee to be established by resolution of Commission
- No license/tag/title for golf cart -- drivers are to be aged 14 and up; people who have lost license; elderly
- Inspections –will be required with details to be worked out later

The signs should be big enough to be noticed.


- a) CDD Rector stated the bus shelter location has been selected. It will be located east of the bike rack closer to the park at the Library.


