1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Bell called the meeting to order at 7:32 p.m.

2. MINUTES

On motion of Commissioner Kelly, seconded by Commissioner Gunter and unanimously carried, the Local Planning Agency approved the April 10, 2014 LPA minutes as submitted.

QUASI-JUDICIAL PUBLIC HEARING

3. ORDINANCE 2014-013 Comprehensive Plan Amendment - West of Micro Race-Track Road and North of CR 466A - Applicant and Owner: DR GCS Holdings, LLC Mr. Gerken read into the record, the title of proposed Ordinance 2014-013, the substance of which is as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FLORIDA; FRUITLAND PARK, **PROVIDING** FOR COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENT AMENDING THE FUTURE LAND USE DESIGNATION FROM LAKE COUNTY AGRICULTURE TO COMMERCIAL HIGH INTENSITY IN THE CITY OF FRUITLAND PARK ON THE FUTURE LAND USE MAP ELEMENT OF THE CITY FRUITLAND PARK'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN APPROXIMATELY 1.39+ ACRES OF PROPERTY GENERALLY LOCATED WEST OF MICRO RACETRACK ROAD AND NORTH OF CR 466a: DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO TRANSMIT THE **GOVERNMENTAL AMENDMENT** TO THE APPROPRIATE AGENCIES PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 163, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY: PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
