The appeals must be filed no later than 30 days from the date of the execution or signing date of the written Order that is to be appealed. Any Order issued by the City of Fruitland Park's Code Enforcement-Special Magistrate may be appealed, including the original order, any subsequent orders, an extension order, or a reduction order.



To Whom it May Concern:

On Thursday April 13, 2017, I accompanied the Code Enforcement Officer, Lori Davis to the above mentioned property to provide expert technical assistance in determining whether the building at that location is dangerous.

Upon arriving at the site, I noticed an older double wide mobile home that had a blue tarp on it's roof and which appeared to be listing in some areas. Upon approaching the building, termite damage was evident from several feet away. Upon closer review, termite damage was noted in the roof/rafter system. Termite damage was also noticed that was so extensive, that it had caused damage to the exterior wall surfaces. In one area, the damage was so severe, that the electrical service was starting to fall away from the building.

It has been my experience that when termites make it into the roof system, that it is not possible to repair the structure. This is mainly due to a two-part problem. Termites require moisture to stay alive. In this case, this moisture is due to a leaking roof. That means the termites were afforded the opportunity to eat day and night, thereby causing irreparable damage to the roof and wall system.

Since there is no way to repair the damage done without a complete tear down, I am recommending that the structure be demolished. I say this because this structure would not survive a move and must be demolished on site. If you have any questions, please let me know.









To Whom it May Concern:

On Thursday April 13, 2017, I accompanied the Code Enforcement Officer, Lori Davis to the above mentioned property to provide expert technical assistance in determining whether the building at that location is dangerous.

Upon arriving at the site, I noticed an older double wide mobile home that had a blue tarp on it's roof and which appeared to be listing in some areas. Upon approaching the building, termite damage was evident from several feet away. Upon closer review, termite damage was noted in the roof/rafter system. Termite damage was also noticed that was so extensive, that it had caused damage to the exterior wall surfaces. In one area, the damage was so severe, that the electrical service was starting to fall away from the building.

It has been my experience that when termites make it into the roof system, that it is not possible to repair the structure. This is mainly due to a two-part problem. Termites require moisture to stay alive. In this case, this moisture is due to a leaking roof. That means the termites were afforded the opportunity to eat day and night, thereby causing irreparable damage to the roof and wall system.

Since there is no way to repair the damage done without a complete tear down, I am recommending that the structure be demolished. I say this because this structure would not survive a move and must be demolished on site. If you have any questions, please let me know.
